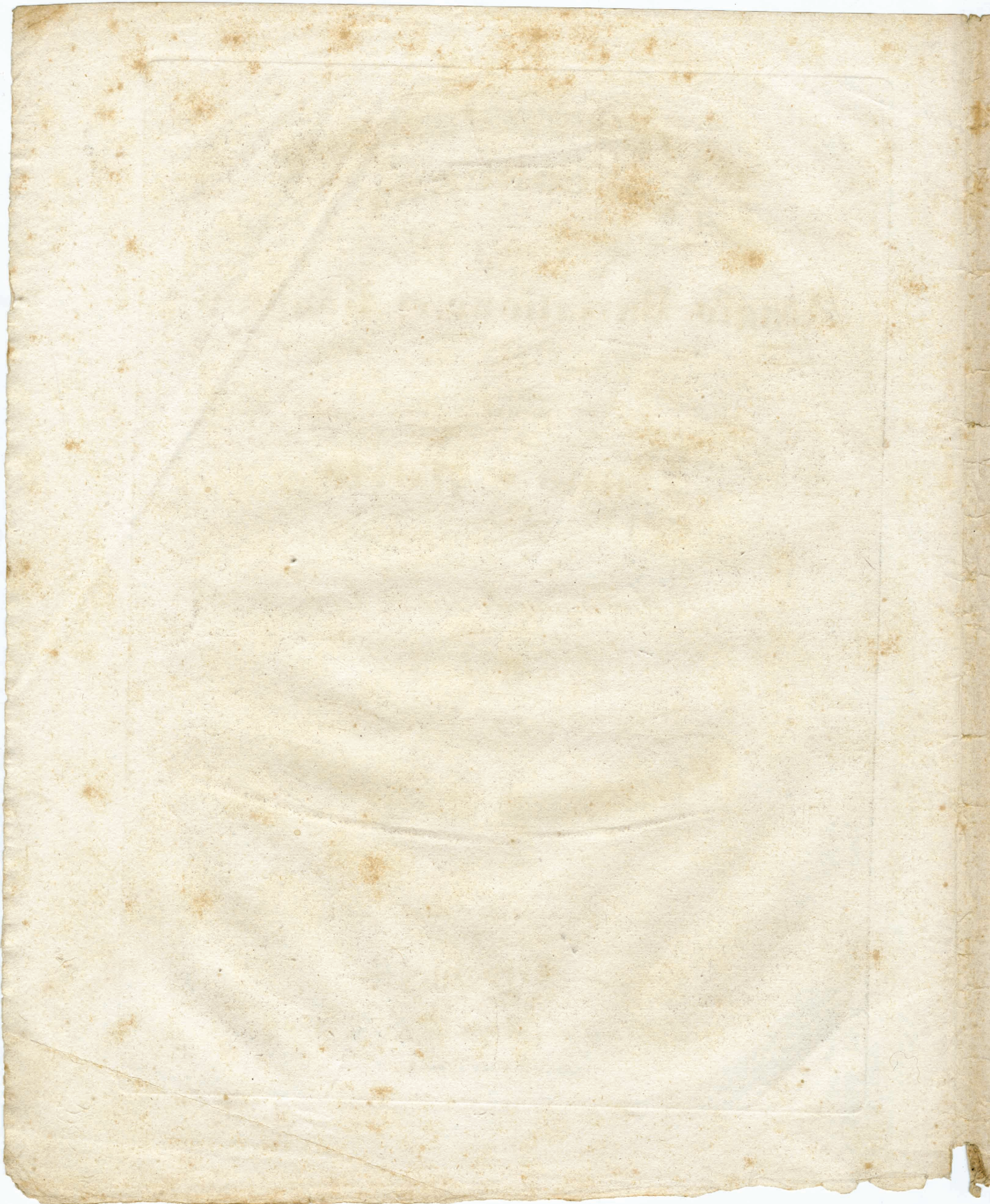

INTRODUZIONE.
