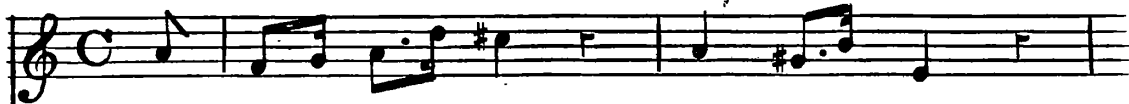

winter on me seizes Since my young Highland Rover, Far wanders nations o - -er.



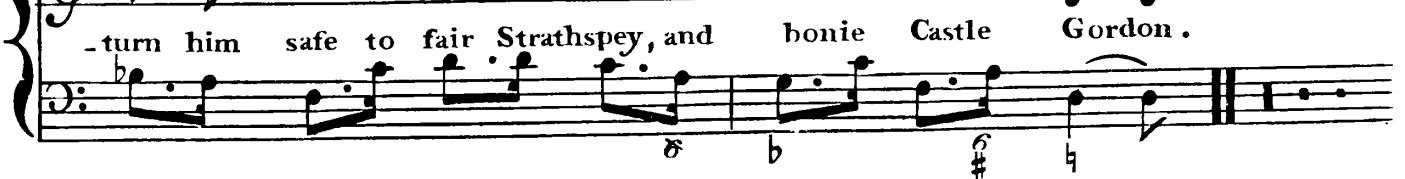
